### Position General Summary

The I&R Specialist provides information and referral services to customers who visit or call Disability Network with a primary focus on providing customers with education and resources on all aspects of disability issues. This position will engage in community education and outreach, as needed, and may provide core independent living case services with more complex requests.

- Complete necessary documentation in NetCIL database
- Represent Disability Network at community events hosted by partner agencies
- Assist in other Disability Network programs as requested
