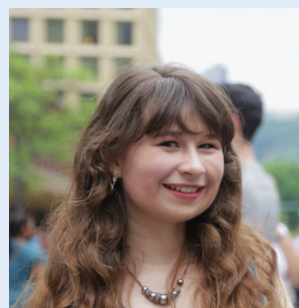
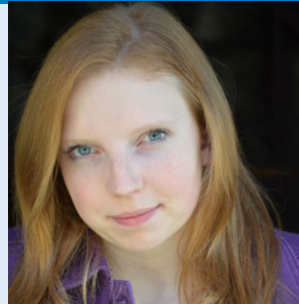
First Up:
